APPLICANT'S EMERGENCY CLAIM STATEMENT

I acknowledge and commit to the following requirements to receive emergency grant assistance through NADBank's Community Assistance Program:

- i. the operational failure of critical infrastructure is due to an act of nature or unforeseen external influence (e.g., power failure/surge, vandalism, unpredictable operational failure);
- ii. the failure has caused, or if not repaired promptly, will cause an acute environmental or human health effect;
- iii. no other sources of funds are immediately accessible and/or sufficient to address the emergency repair; therefore, CAP funds are necessary as the funding of last resort;
- iv. if implemented, the project will fully address the acute environmental or human health effect requiring the repair or replacement of infrastructure, preferably as a permanent solution but to support operation, at least, until a more permanent investment can be completed;
- v. an appropriate reserve, at least equal to the CAP grant amount, will be funded in accordance with the terms and conditions of the financing agreement; and
- vi. sufficient revenue for continued operation and maintenance of the repaired infrastructure will be sufficiently allocated by the project sponsor.
